

This facility and all of its programs and activities are accessible to and usable by disabled persons, including persons with impaired vision and hearing. Access features include:



- Convenient parking designated specifically for disabled persons
- Heated curb cuts and ramps between parking areas and buildings
- Level access into first floor level with elevator access to all other floors
- Fully accessible offices, meeting rooms, bathrooms, public waiting areas, cafeteria and patient examination, treatment and care areas
- A range of assistive and communication aids provided to persons with impaired hearing, vision, speech or manual skills, without additional charge for such aids that may include:
 - Qualified sign language interpreters for the deaf
 - 24 hour telecommunication device for the deaf (TTY/TDD)
 - Readers or taped materials for the blind and large print materials for the visually impaired
 - Flash cards, alphabet boards and other communication boards
 - Assistive devices for persons with impaired manual skills
